What is The Journey to Bethlehem?

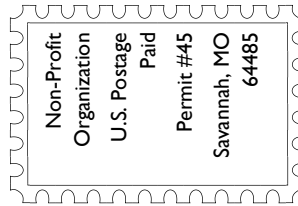

Living a Healthy Life Presented to you by Mosaic Life Care

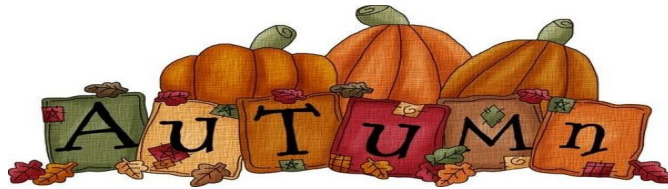
